

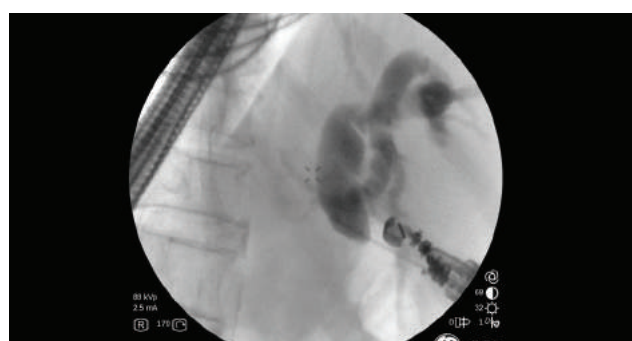
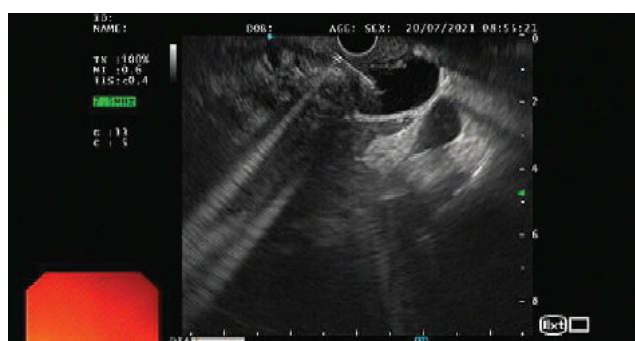
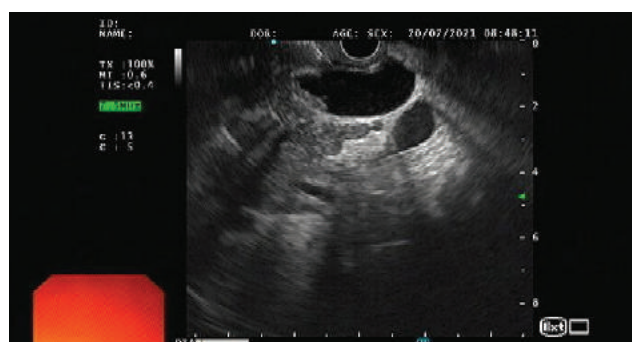
CASE OF THE WEEK

70-year-old undergoes successful EUS Guided Biliary Drainage Choledochoduodenostomy(CDS)

Mrs. Sundari Mishra, a 70-year old woman, from Krishna Nagar, Lucknow presented to Apollomedics Lucknow with **obstructive Jaundice , pain in abdomen, fever and itching all over body for almost a month**. Her CT outside was s/o periampullary growth with liver SOL. She underwent EUS guided FNA from distal CBD growth & also USG guided FNA for liver, which was s/o cholangiocarcinoma with metastasis liver.

ERCP was attempted but deep cannulation could not be achieved. PTBD was attempted but failed due to inadequate dilatation of peripheral IHBR. She underwent EUS guided Choledochoduodenostomy(CSD) by which a communication was made between common bile duct and duodenum through a metal stent under endoscopic ultrasound guidance. Free flow from bile was observed. There were no post procedure complications. Post Procedure, the patient was relieved of her symptoms and serum bilirubin came down from 20 mg/dl to 6 ml/dl in 2-week time. Patient was haemodynamically stable at the time of her discharge and is now eligible for Chemotherapy.



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
