

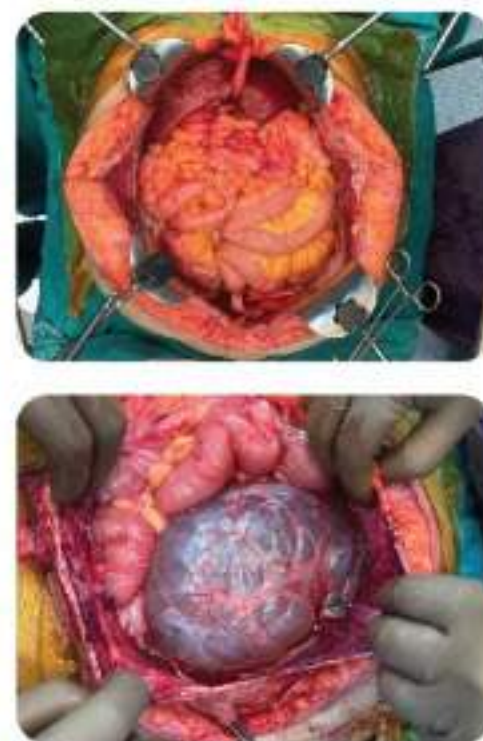
CASE OF THE WEEK

**55-year-old undergoes successful HIPEC Surgery performed by
Dr. Kamlesh Verma, Consultant, Surgical Oncology**

AT APOLLOMEDICS HOSPITALS, LUCKNOW

A 55-year-old female presented with complaint of abdominal pain & discomfort on & off since last surgery. Patient had undergone right Salpingo-oophorectomy & total omentectomy on 29/08/21 outside, pseudomyxoma peritonei. On evaluation, her CECT, whole abdomen revealed **large septated cystic mass measuring 118x 220x 184mm in lower peritoneal space abutting both adnexa**. fat plane with ileal loop, sigmoid colon and fundus of uterus was poorly defined. Small lesions measuring 51x55 mm was also noted in cul-de-sac region.

CA 125 – 602 U/ml, CEA – 8.3 ng/ml, CA 19.9-8.21 u/ml. She underwent Total Omentectomy + Peritonectomy + Hysterectomy + left Salpingo-oophorectomy + Splenectomy, + Appendectomy + Hyperthermic intraperitoneal Chemotherapy (**HIPEC**), **Chemotherapy (Mitomycin - c: 25 mg and Adriamycin: 25 mg)** was given intra peritoneally for 90 min at 42 degrees centigrade. She was then kept under strict supervision with all critical care monitoring. Intra-operative & post-operative period was uneventful. She was discharged on 10th post-operative day in stable condition. Patient is now disease free and under regular follow-up.
