



PITFALLS OF FROZEN SECTION

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Pitfalls of Frozen Section

29 year old Mr. M came to see me from Bangladesh, with a lump in his left testis. 3 years back, he had the same issue and underwent frozen section biopsy and was diagnosed with Leydig Cell Tumor - a common benign tumor of the testis.

Recurrence of lump made him to visit Apollo Hospitals. He experienced no pain and showed no other symptoms. On examination, he had hard left testis about 5 cm. No groin nodes. He had no mass or any other lymph node enlargement. His tumor markers were normal. USG showed heterogeneous mass with central necrosis. His CT of the chest and abdomen was otherwise normal. He underwent left radical orchideomy and recovered well. His histology showed Seminoma. His histological features indicated a high risk of recurrence. He was referred to oncologist for chemotherapy.

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
